

# Nomination for Fine Arts Hall of Fame

## London City Schools

### Background/Purpose:

The Fine Arts Hall of Fame was founded in 2014 by the London Music Boosters. Its primary purpose is to recognize individuals/groups with ties to London City Schools who have made an important, positive impact on the Arts community in our schools, the local community or the global community at large.

### Eligibility for Nomination: (one or more of the following)

1. Attended a school in the London City School District
2. Employed by London City Schools
3. Provided support or volunteered in some capacity for London City Schools
4. Demonstrated significant achievement or contribution to the Arts – in London City Schools, locally or globally
5. Nominees should be connected to any of the Fine Arts, such as:

### Nominating Process:

1. Nominations may be made by anyone connected to the London community.
2. It is the responsibility of the nominator to provide personal information and a record of the Arts achievements/contributions of the nominee.
3. Completed nomination forms must be received in the London High School principal's office by January 31 to be considered for the current school year's inductions.

### Criteria for Selection:

1. Long-term contribution to the Arts in London City Schools as student, alumni, educator or citizen
2. Important, positive impact to the Arts in the London area community
3. Important, positive impact to the Arts in the global community

### Voting Process:

1. Eligibility of nominations received will be determined by a Hall of Fame Committee appointed by the London Music Boosters president.
2. Eligible nominees will be voted on by the London Music Boosters Executive Committee.
3. A nominee is selected to become a member of the Fine Arts Hall of Fame when a minimum of 75% of votes cast are in favor of induction.
4. Nominees not selected in their initial year of nomination will automatically be a candidate for consideration in the following two voting years. In the event a nominee is not selected after three consecutive voting years, the nomination must be resubmitted.
